# NEXT WEEK IN PUBLIC POLICY

## NOVEMBER 12 – NOVEMBER 16, 2018

### IN OHIO:

On Tuesday, November 13, 2018, the Senate Judiciary Committee will hold a 4<sup>th</sup> Hearing on [House Bill 309 \(Blindness – Guardianship and Adoption\)](#). The bill would make it illegal for an individual's blindness to be used to deny or limit custody, parenting time, visitation, adoption, or services as a guardian or foster caregiver of a minor. ALL witnesses are invited to testify. The committee has scheduled a possible vote on the bill. The hearing will take place in the North Hearing Room of the Ohio Senate Building.

On Tuesday, November 13, 2018, the Senate Health, Human Services and Medicaid Committee will hold its 4<sup>th</sup> Hearing on [House Bill 119 \(SNAP and Medicaid Benefits\)](#). The bill creates a “change in circumstances” scenario that would require SNAP or Medicaid to re-verify eligibility for services. The change in circumstances could be suspected fraud or the receipt of any information that is considered valid for review of eligibility. ALL witnesses are invited to testify. The hearing will take place at 3:15 p.m. in the South Hearing Room of the Ohio Senate Building.

On Wednesday, November 14, 2018, the House Health Committee will hold SPONSOR Testimony on [House Bill 659 \(Prescription Drug Reader\)](#). The bill would require pharmacies to provide, at the request of a customer, a prescription drug reader for any prescription of a controlled substance, to assist individuals who are visually impaired, for the period of the prescription. The hearing will take place at 9:00 a.m.

On Thursday, November 15, 2018, the Joint Medicaid Oversight Committee will hold a hearing to receive a presentation from Optumas. Optumas is an actuary that provides independent analysis of the fiscal status of Medicaid and Medicaid programs for the committee. The hearing will take place at 9:00 a.m. in the North Hearing Room of the Ohio Senate.

On Thursday, November 15, 2018, the Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities Agency will be accepting public comment on three proposed rules. The three rules include: [Duties of the OOD Executive Director](#); [Updating Agency Name in Audit Rule](#); and [Updating name and other in Minority Business Enterprise Rule](#). Any and all public comments on these proposed rule changes will be accepted at 10:30 a.m. in the Roger Flint Conference Room at 150 East Campus View Blvd., Columbus, OH.

On Friday, November 16, 2018, the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities will be accepting public comment on proposed rule changes related to Home and Community Based Services Waivers. There are 18 rules that are proposed for changes. An outline of the proposed rule changes can be found [here](#). Public comment will begin at 10:00 a.m. in the Lobby Hearing Room of the Rhodes State Office Tower, 30 E. Broad St., Columbus, OH 43215.

## IN WASHINGTON:

On Thursday, November 15, 2018, the US House Committee on Veteran's Affairs, Subcommittee on Disability Assistance and Memorial Affairs, will hold a hearing entitled "Exploring VA's Oversight of Contract Disability Examinations." The hearing will take place at 10:30 a.m. in Room 334 of the Cannon House Office Building.
